## Self sealing tail piece on chrome valves

We are introducing self sealing nipples on our chrome valves.

These tail pieces makes it easyer and quicker to mount the valves as no packing will be necessary.

The sealing is made via an o-ring and the radiator connection must not have burs or other sharp edges that might damage the o-ring. If the radiator connection do not live up to this, the thread on the tail piece can be packed traditionally.

The tail piece also solves a problem we have experienced where the painting on the radiator have cracked when mounting the valve. These cracks will over time cause the radiator to corrode at the connecition, and corrosion will run down the valve. These new tail pieces ensure that corrosion will not run down the valve.
